**Martha's Vineyard Bank Announces its 3 Nominated Non-Profits are Recipients of Massachusetts Banker's Association Charitable Foundation Annual Grants**

**Edgartown, MA** – Martha's Vineyard Bank announced today that all three of the local non-profits that the Bank nominated to the Massachusetts Banker's Association Charitable Foundation were awarded Honorable Mention grants for \$1,500 each.

The three organizations are Habitat for Humanity on Martha's Vineyard, Falmouth Service Center, and Belonging to Each Other in Falmouth (a winter homeless shelter). As a member of the Massachusetts Banker's Association, Martha's Vineyard Bank annually nominates local non-profits for these grants. Overall, there were 50 grants totaling \$160,000 awarded by Massachusetts Banker's Association Charitable Foundation, which has 120 member-banks in Massachusetts and New England.
